Project Pathway



We are praising God for the incredible progress on Project Pathway! Over the past month, Wayne Eudy has widened and leveled nearly half a mile of what will soon become a two-way connection with Desert Road—paving the way for greater access and future growth. God has also provided a wonderful deal on two 5' x 30' culvert pipes, which have been leveled and buried to manage runoff. All of the dirt needed for this work is coming from our new shooting range and a future site where we are asking God to provide an 80 x 40 metal storage facility.

While the project is moving forward wonderfully, we still seek the Lord's provision through financial support to purchase \$50,000 worth of gravel. We are also hoping for a brother or sister with heavy machinery to help clear trees and move dirt. Your prayers, encouragement, and contributions will make a lasting impact on this exciting initiative.
