# Conduct all camp activities with the mission and purpose of Camp Shenandoah Springs.

- No loud music before 8am or after 10 pm.
- Please do not use tape on walls, doors, windows, ceilings, etc. Thumbtacks are permitted.
- No furniture is to be removed form the buildings without consulting management.
- Pictures, flags, decor, etc in all buildings must be left in its place as is, unless special consent comes from management.
- Keep buildings and facilities clean and orderly.
- There is refrigeration for our guests, especially for those on medications or special diets, etc. Ice is available on request.
- You must receive approval for campfires from camp manager.
- Please prevent destruction and disruption of trees, plants, and all-natural growth on camp property.
- Group leaders assume the responsibility for any damage or injury to the participants, the property, facilities, structures, or equipment.
- If your number of your group changes, we need a minimum of 1 week's notification or you pay the full amount.
- All groups need to pay for a minimum of 20 people.
- When showering, slide curtains across fully and keep the bottom of the curtain in the shower, to keep water off the floors.
- If a sink drain or commode gets stopped-up, please notify staff immediately so it may be fixed.
- Toilet paper is provided for all restrooms; please notify staff if it becomes low.
- Soap, paper towels, etc are provided in common restrooms (Thunderlodge). You are responsible for your own soap, shampoo, etc in your cabins etc.



- All leaders are background checked
- Life guards/instructors are certified
- Radios
- Nurse(s) present
- Please notify a staff member of any behavior or hazards that could be a potential danger.
- Do not block roads/exits, gates, or behind
   Thunderlodge
- Parking is along either side of the white gate above the office/camp store.
- Keep as close as possible to the next vehicle to ensure enough space for others.





- Absolutely NO SWIMMING without a CSS approved and certified lifeguard on duty. Inquire first before planning any water activity.
- A life jacket must be worn while using any watercraft.
- Canoes and flotation apparatus at the lake are to be take out of the water, turned on its side, and the life vests hung up after each use.
- Fishing available. Catch and release only.
- All garbage bags are to be tied 'dog-eared' and placed in the dump trailer behind Thunder Lodge
- Camp Shenandoah Springs will provide trash bags for the trash cans daily. Please bring extras if you need bags for dirty laundry, ponchos, etc.





- Remove all trash from your rooms and set the bags on the front porch.
- Sweep floors
- Remove personal belongings
- All furniture, tables, and chairs etc are to be replaced to original position, as it was on arrival.
- Double check cleaning list in each building you use
- Check out with the Camp Director






Thunder Lodge

#### Uncle Jay's Cabin

If you're looking for more of a rustic place to getaway, Uncle Jay's Cabin is the place to be! Nestled in the surrounding woods, and overlooking the lake, it sleeps 4; no water or electric but has a wood burning

Uncle J's Cabin: \$100/night (up to 4 people)

#### Heritage House and Cherokee



The original historical farm house; it has been updated to include a kitchen and as well as a bathroom with 2 sinks, stalls, and showers. Rent both or only one portion. Main house (with kitchen) sleeps 11, side wing sleeps 6.

Heritage: \$450/night (up to 11 people) Cherokee: \$210/night (up to 6 people)



# COMMIC SOON

#### Choctaw

This rustic, open air, cabin sleeps 15. It is situated in an open area of the woods, allowing for accompanying tent camping and is located a stones throw from the lakeside fire pit. Recommended use during late spring through early fall only.

Tent Camping: \$15/ night per person (BYO tent)

# Dining

Located on the main floor of Thunder Lodge, we provide an assortment of dining options with a large, 2 level dining area where groups can gather and enjoy food & fellowship.

#### Salad Bar

# Outdoor Amenities Spring House

A large paved pavilion (w/ stage & electricity).

### Lake Life

Lake Shalom is spring fed and stocked with large/small mouth bass, brim, and crappie. At a depth of ~15 feet deep, this lake is perfect for all sorts of water activities.

**Outdoor Sanctuary** 

With bench seating and a beautiful stone fire pit, this area sits at the foot of the cross overlooking Camp Shenandoah Springs' green pastures and still waters. There are 14 benches at ~12 feet long with additional space for chairs if needed.



# Outdoor Amenities

## Lakeside Firepit

This large camping site is situated in the woods, just a stone's throw from the lake. The stone fire pit, bench seating, and two porta bathrooms, makes this a perfect spot for camp cooking, s'mores, or an overnight stay.





### Athletic Field

Our field is 300' x 150' and is complete with a field goal post. This field is perfect for football, soccer, capture the flag, field hockey, OMC (Organized Mass Chaos), ultimate frisbee, and more.
